Change to Dental Services

The Honourable Minister for Health Martin Foley recently announced significant changes to the public Dental Services for Aboriginal community members available from 1 July 2021

All Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander people can now access priority dental services whether they hold a health care card or not with no gap payment (general & emergency appointments). This is something our CEO and ACCHO's across the State have been advocating for a number of years. This is great news for our community and those in need of treatment.



Local Justice

The Local Justice worker is part of a dynamic and wide-reaching program that supports Aboriginal men and women who are involved in the Victorian Justice System. This could include people facing court, under a corrections order, or those in prison. The Local Justice worker is committed to achieving better outcomes for Aboriginal people involved with the Victorian Justice System. The service is culturally sensitive, respectful, confidential, and able to provide both emotional and practical support to clients.

Aims and Objectives

- Contribute to improved justice outcomes for Aboriginal peoples in the Victorian South West
- Provide help to all Aboriginal people over the age of 18 that are dealing with the justice system
- Support clients when facing court, incarcerated in jail, placed under Community and Parole Orders, or having issues with police
- Give practical help with reducing outstanding fines
- Ensure no Aboriginal member of our local community faces court or the justice system alone

We do this by supporting you with:

- Case management
- Advocacy
- Referrals to support services
- Court Support
- Providing support to access legal advice and cultural connection













Clinic News

COVID Related:

We are holding COVID Clinics every Wednesday 9.30 - 7.45pm with great response from community.

Every ATSI patient to get a vaccination has been getting a free meal from Tasty plate or a voucher to select their own meal directly from the shop.

We have currently vaccinated 254 people from the whole community = 160 people have had their 1^{st} dose and already 94 people having has their 2^{nd} dose and are fully vaccinated.

Remembering to always opt for a phone consult if you are experiencing any COVID symptoms - get tested and isolate.

If you need any assistance during your isolation period – we are here to assist you with your medical needs to make it easier for you.

All allied services are back on site - Dietician / Optometrist / Dentist - Call the Clinic and speak to reception for eligibility requirements on services.

Bev has been very busy with transports these last few weeks, remember if you need to book transport do it at the most earliest convenience so we can allocate enough time for you.

Also just a reminder that transport is only offered to those in the community who identify as ATSI and who have no other means of transport. (3)
